After graduating from Springfield's Technical High School in 1938, Ray Carr planned to go to college, but his family's savings fell \$40 short of the tuition fee. That's when Ray received a letter awarding him a \$50 football scholarship. He never forgot that gift. After graduating from American International College in 1942, Ray served his country as a decorated Marine Corps aviator in World War II. In

1946, he played minor league baseball for the Brooklyn Dodgers, and then went on to an accounting career at Monarch Life Insurance Company. After retiring, he spent the rest of his life caring for his mother, playing golf and planning his legacy. Ray donated nearly his entire estate to the Foundation, establishing the *Raymond E. Carr Scholarship Fund* to provide annual scholarships to local students in perpetuity.
